COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION

FEBRUARY TO APRIL 2017

The Juris Partnership, comprising Laing O'Rourke, Macquarie Capital and their delivery partners, is delivering a new \$160 million justice precinct for the Australian Capital Territory.

The ACT Law Courts project in the centre of Canberra is the Territory's first public-private partnership (PPP).

The project will create a combined Law Courts facility for the ACT which will maximise operational efficiencies whilst still respecting the jurisdictional separation between the Supreme Court and the Magistrates Court.

FEBRUARY TO APRIL WORKS

From February to April 2017 Laing O'Rourke (for Juris Partnership) will:

- *continue with precast and structural steel installation ground to level 2*
- *continue internal Magistrate Courts facility refurbishment works*
- *continue Registry decant works on the ground floor of the Magistrate's Court*
- *complete final electrical diversion works to the Supreme Court*

WHAT ARE THE IMPACTS?

Internal Magistrate Court Facility access: remains though the main entry points and internal way-finding will be in place where access changes.

Footpath access: The footpath along Knowles Place in front of the new facility construction works between the Magistrates and Supreme Court buildings periodically will be disrupted from construction vehicles crossing the footpath. Traffic management will be in place to maintain safe access.

The alternative access route in front of Supreme Court will remain in place until end of April 2017 for electrical services diversion works.

Footpath access along Vernon Circle will remain closed for the duration of the works.

Traffic and access management: Temporary traffic measures will be in place to ensure access to both court buildings from Knowles Place (including trolley/pram/wheeled access points), through all phases of the works. Temporary traffic management to Vernon Circle will continue to be in place throughout the project. Increased truck access / re-entering on Vernon Circle will continue throughout the project.

Construction works: Laing O'Rourke will continue to apply noise and vibration mitigations in construction methodology with building works for the new facility.

We apologise for any inconvenience these works may cause. We will provide regular updates throughout the construction works detailing potential impacts on the surrounding community.
