

ACT COURTS PROJECT COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION

TRAFFIC AND PEDESTRIAN ACCESS CHANGES SATURDAY 11 - SUNDAY 12 MARCH

The Juris Partnership, comprising Laing O'Rourke, Macquarie Capital and their delivery partners, is delivering a new \$150 million justice precinct for the Australian Capital Territory.

The ACT Law Courts project in the centre of Canberra is the Territory's first public-private partnership (PPP).

The project will create a combined Law Courts facility for the ACT which will maximise operational efficiencies whilst still respecting the jurisdictional separation between the Supreme Court and the Magistrates Court.

TEMPORARY EXCLUSION ZONE FOR CRANE INSTALLTION VIA KNOWLES PLACE

Due to crane installation works next Saturday 11 and provisionally Sunday 12 March, an exclusion zone will be in place between 5am on Saturday morning and 7pm on Sunday evening in Knowles Place, Canberra.

The zone between the Magistrates Car Park entry and exit, to mid-way across the court yard between the Reserve Bank of Australia and the Canberra City Police Station, will be managed by traffic and pedestrian controls to facilitate the safe transit and installation of a second tower crane to the ACT Courts Project during the weekend, outside of business hours.

WHAT ARE THE IMPACTS?

Vehicle access - Magistrates Car Park and Court, and Canberra City Police Station

- Vehicle access to and from the Magistrates Car Park will be changed to two-way London Circuit access
- Vehicle access to the Magistrates Court will remain unchanged, however traffic management will be in place and some short delays may be experienced as the crane components are trucked into site via London Circuit and Knowles Place
- Vehicle access to and from the Canberra City Police Station will only be via London Circuit
- Delivery vehicles and trucks carrying crane components will access and exit London Circuit under traffic management controls to ensure the safety of pedestrians and other vehicles in the area.

Pedestrian access

- Full access to the Magistrates Court and the Children's Court will be maintained with traffic and pedestrian management in place
- Pedestrian access from the western car park will be diverted through the courtyard between the Police Station and the Reserve Bank onto London Circuit.

SC Sally Port car park access

-There will be no access to the SC Sally Port driveway and car park during these weekend crane installation works.

We apologise for any inconvenience these works may cause, and appreciate your patience as the second tower crane is installed on the ACT Law Courts Project site.
